Earlier this week [I asked if anyone who reads this blog might be willing to help me with the creation of an ebook](#) that would feature some of my recent Twitter threads since they had appeared to have resonated with a good number of people.

Several people offered, to whom I am grateful. I chose to work with David Mullins, who is a graphic designer. The result is that I can now report that the proposed eBook (which will be most readily available as a PDF) has a title, cover and more than 90 per cent of its contents.
