

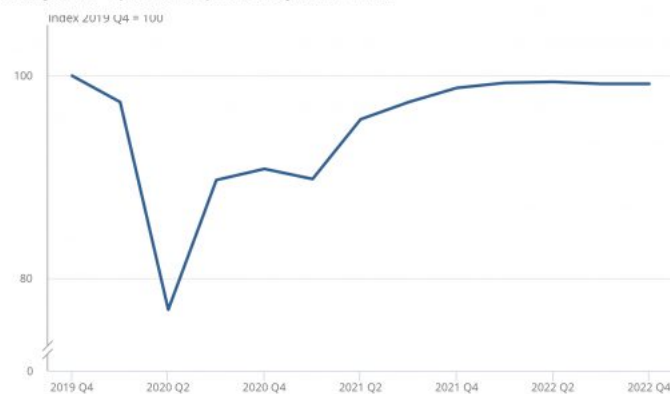
Flatlining
