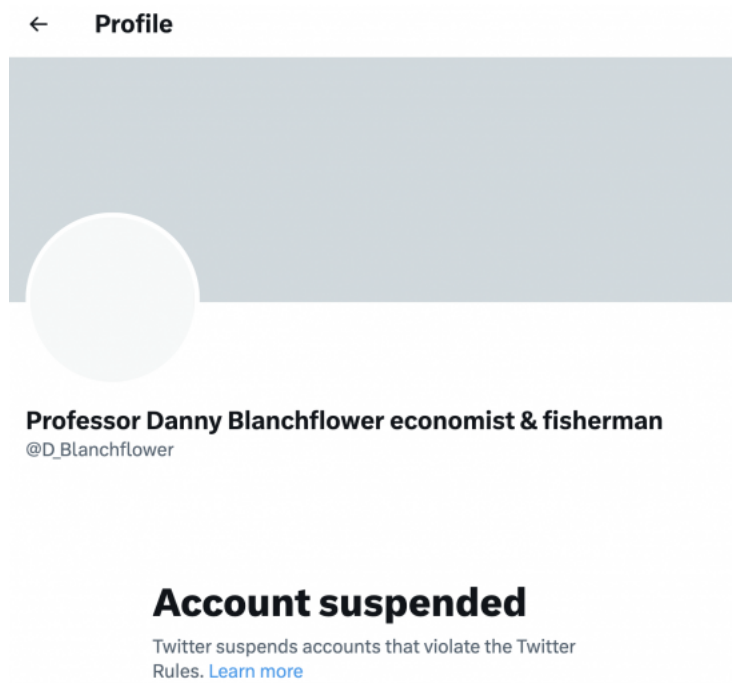


The world is unfair and anti-democratic
