

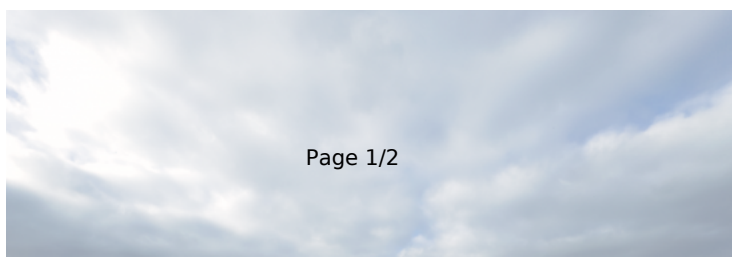
Skeins
