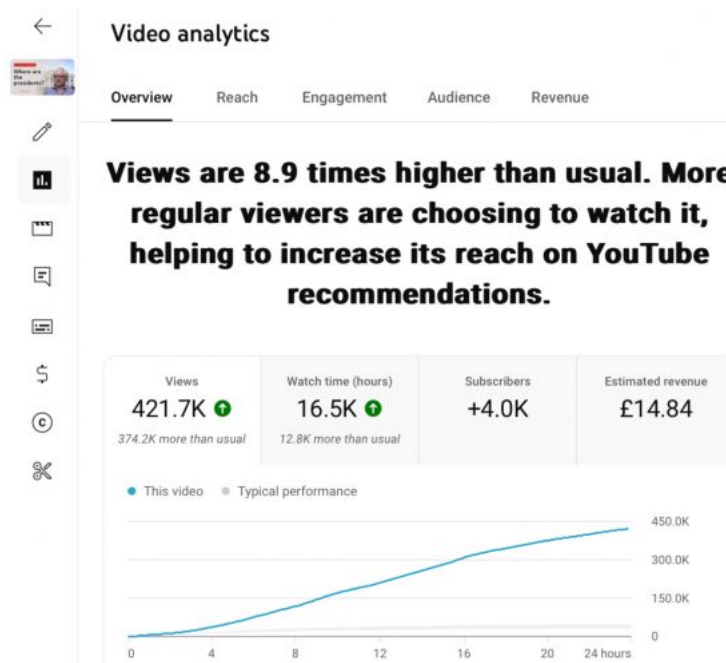


Funding the Future
