Dear Richard Murphy,

Sorry, we can't accept your petition – “Withdraw the invitation for a state visit to the UK by President Trump”.

It calls for an action relating to a particular individual, or organisation outside of the UK Government or Parliament.

We cannot accept petitions that call for an action relating to a particular individual, including the President of the United States.
