Three days after Israel said it had eased its blockade of Gaza to let aid trucks in, very little — if any — of the urgently needed [food, fuel and medicine appeared to have reached Palestinians](#).

A panel of U.N.-backed experts warned this month that Gazans were at “critical risk of famine,” with tens of thousands of children facing acute malnutrition. Israel dismissed the report.

Trump is not mentioning it. He is still, very clearly, Netanyahu's best friend.

We have a bigot, a racist, a supporter of genocide, and a person dedicated to ending the rule of law in the White House.
