- * Ditto for the more recent occupation of Syria?
- * Do Palestinians have an internationally recognised right of self-determination?
- * Do occupied peoples have an internationally recognised right to forcefully resist occupation?
- * Do Palestinians have an internationally recognised right to both forcefully resist occupation and an internationally recognised right of self-defence?
- * Is the modern state of Israel, created by international agreement, bound by international law
- * What do you understand by the term “rogue state” and how should they be dealt with by the international community?
- * What will happen to Benjamin Netanyahu and his wife when he is no longer Prime Minister?
