

Country-by-country reporting is working

The Inclusive Framework on BEPS has released the latest annual peer review results on the implementation of the BEPS Action 13 minimum standard on Country-by-Country Reporting (CbCR). Covering 142 jurisdictions, the report shows how governments are increasingly exchanging information on large multinational groups to curb tax avoidance. The results highlight continued progress and reflect how CbCR is a central tool in strengthening global tax transparency.
